Home Support

Every single family is different so our experienced coordinators get to know a family so we can tailor our support service to individual needs.

Family support coordinators work with parents/carers to:

- Support parents/carers to manage challenging behaviours
- Instil confidence in parents abilities to leave the home environment on trips out to the park or support groups
- Create resources tailored to a particular child.
- Be a supporting presence for families attending school meetings, EHCP Mediation appointments
- Provide support so children are safe on trips out the home.



We are here to help the SEND journey to be as smooth as possible and understand that day-to-day life for families with SEND children is not always straightforward or conventional, and we are happy to support with many strategies that help along the way.

We help equip families with the tools and information they need to feel empowered and proud of where they are now, and where they are headed in the future.



Groups

Families will find an unstructured and relaxed approach in our groups.. Children will have various opportunities to play, learn and be around others. Families do not have to worry about sitting still at a story time or joining in with games and songs; the opportunity to read, sing and play is available for all, but in a child's own time and in their own way.



A quiet space is always offered for those who need some down time to decompress or regulate, and our Families Together Suffolk staff are always on hand to support parents and children through these difficult times.
